Franchise spreads wings

Buffalo Wild Wings has new location

FLINT TWP. — The Buffalo Wild Wings franchise wants to continue expanding north, and it has made another stop in the Flint area.

Buffalo Wild Wings opened a location at 3192 S. Linden Road in Flint Township on Dec. 21.

The franchise is known for its wings. It has boneless and bone-in wings with a variety of flavors from mild to super spicy.

The franchise, which has many locations in southeast Michigan, wanted to open new locations in untapped areas in

other parts of the state, said Ryan Hays, manager of the Flint Township location.

"Most of our locations are on the south side of M-59," Hays said. "We're trying to move up this way to try and corner the market."

The restaurant has a capacity of 398 people and has 92 employees. It plans to maintain a staff of about 70 to 75 people, Hays said.

The restaurant sells 12 regular wings for \$7.99. It also sells cheeseburgers and fries for \$7.29. And the dipping sauces

are second to none, Hays said. "Nobody's got better sauces than what we do," he said.

Buffalo Wild Wings has both smoking and nonsmoking sections and has a full bar with several televisions.

"You have TVs surrounding you on every single wall," Hays said. "People come for more the atmosphere than the food. We can have multiple games on.

You can see whatever game you want."

There are also Buffalo Wild Wings restaurants in Grand Blanc and Fenton.

Hours are 11 a.m. to 1 a.m. Monday through Thursday, 11 a.m. to 2 a.m. Friday and Saturday and noon to midnight Sunday.
